

Drug Instructions for Nitroglycerin

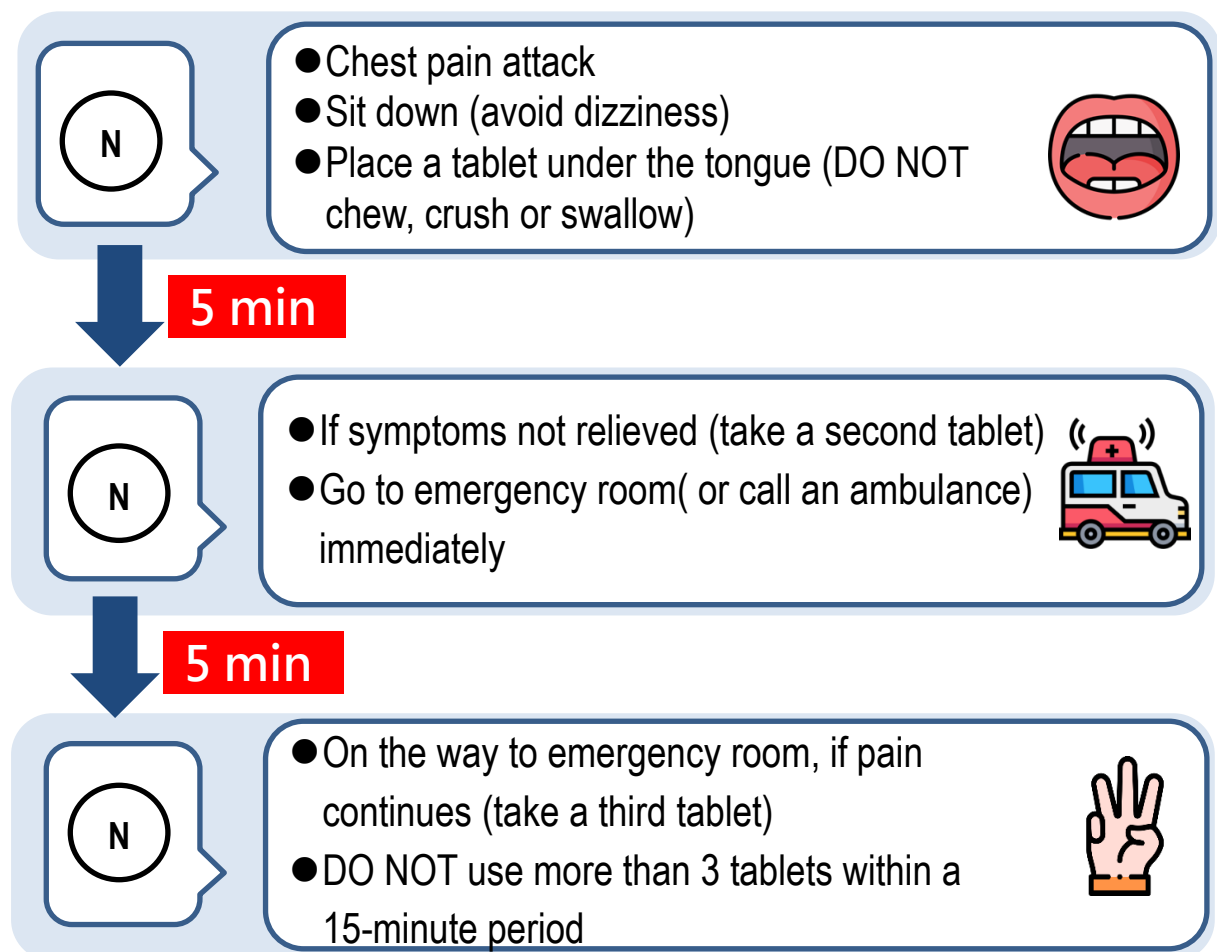
Drug information

- **Brand name:** Nitroglycerin (NITROSTAT®)
- **Content:** 0.6 mg/tab
- **Purpose:** Prevent or relive symptoms of



angina attacks (such as chest pain, chest tightness or dyspnea)

How to Use?



Precautions

- Common side effects of NITROSTAT® include **dizziness**, **headache** or **tingling under the tongue**. If symptoms persist or severe, please go to hospital for treatment immediately.
- Avoid keeping the tablet on your hand for too long as it may become moist and reduce the effectiveness.
- DO NOT take NITROSTAT® with Viagra®, Levitra®, and Cialis®.

Storage

- NITROSTAT® should be kept in the original glass container and tightly capped after each use to prevent loss of effectiveness.
- Make sure the tablets are sufficient and pay attention to the expiry date.
- Store at room temperature and carry with you when you go out.
- DO NOT use the tablets after being crushed. You should return to the doctor for a new bottle.



Tip points

When chest pain attacks, sit down and take the medicine under the tongue. If it is not relieved, take one tablet every five minutes, up to three tablets, and go to hospital as soon as possible.
